

### Tan Tock Seng Hospital, Singapore

Tan Tock Seng Hospital (TTS) is the second largest acute care general hospital in Singapore. Since 2013, it is also the designated teaching hospital for the newest medical school in Singapore.

Established in 1844, the hospital is named after its founder, Mr Tan Tock Seng, a Chinese philanthropist. TTS is a member of the National Healthcare Group and continues to provide high quality holistic healthcare services to the public. After three major moves in its long and distinguished history, the 1,200-bed hospital now provides most of its services in one modern complex equipped with state-of-the-art facilities and medical equipment, as well as the latest communication and information technology tools.

TTS attained the Joint Commission International (JCI) accreditation by the Joint Commission Accreditation of Healthcare Organisations (JCAHO), USA, in August 2005, an award that represents a worldwide consensus on quality patient care.

The TTS Invasive Cardiac Laboratory is housed in a new state-of-the-art facility with 3 angiographic suites dedicated to interventional cardiology. The facility was designed by harnessing 3P (Production-Preparation-Process) and Kaizen principles to ensure a faster, safer and more efficacious management of acute STEMI. Around 3000 diagnostic procedures and 1,600 PCIs are performed annually. Transradial route is the preferred arterial access accounting for close to 90% of all PCI cases.

### HKSTENT

HKSTENT is the first and only formal Interventional Cardiology Society registered as a charitable organization in Hong Kong. It was founded with the aim of promoting education, research, and advancement of Interventional Cardiology in Hong Kong and Asia for the benefit of interventionalists, cardiologists, allied health workers, and the general public at large.

At the same time, HKCC also continue mutually beneficial interactions with professional communities around the world.
